Full Day Session 8:15 am – 3:15 pm (7 hours)

Monthly Pricing for Full Day: \$490 a month for 3 days a week
\$545 a month for 4 days a week
\$655 a month for 5 days a week

Our Extra Care hours are from 7:30 – 8:15 am and 3:30 – 4:30 pm which is an extra charge of \$1.00 per five to fifteen minutes.

Materials fee due by the first day of school: (one time nonrefundable fee)

\$95 for Half Day Students
\$140 for Full Day Students

Payment Plans: Tuition may be paid annually or monthly. However, two week's tuition and registration fee needs to accompany this contract. Annual payments made by September 15, will receive a 5% discount on tuition. **All payments are due by the 1st of each month.** A \$20.00 late fee will be assessed to payments after the 15th of each month. There is a tuition discount of \$90.00 per year per child for two or more children of the same parent. A \$20.00 fee will be assessed for any return checks.

Registration fee and two week's tuition must accompany this contract. Materials fee is due by the first day of school. It is understood that this contract may be cancelled if the school is notified prior to August 1 and that the school will refund any prepaid tuition in full within 30 days of receipt of cancellation notice. If written notice of cancellation is made after August 1, one fifth of two week's tuition amount will be deducted from refund for each week of part thereof after August 1. To cancel this contract after the school term has begun, 14 days written notice is required and any prepaid tuition remaining on the account beyond that 14 days will be returned to you. The school reserves the right to discharge a student for any reason whatsoever at any time, and in such event shall refund any prepaid tuition in full. The school will exercise such discretion only in the event it deems such action necessary in the best interest of the child or in the best interest of the other students.

The most important goal of our early childhood curriculum is to help children become enthusiastic learners. This means encouraging children to be active explorers who are not afraid to try out their ideas and to think their own thoughts. Our goal is to help children become independent, self-confident, inquisitive learners, who are able to learn at their own pace and in the ways that are best for them.



Montessori Education — Play is an essential part of early learning. As children play they are developing the cognitive, socio-emotional and physical skills they will need to take them into a successful adulthood. They are developing their curiosity, problem solving, intentionality, flexibility, and verbal and non-verbal skills.

Toddlers are encouraged to actively explore, enjoy, see, hear, feel touch and move. They need a world filled with responsive interactions and language-conversations with others, books, songs, and lots of listening and responding to their vocalizations and words. They will work on the beginning fundamentals such as shapes, colors, language skills, social skills, counting, days of the week, name recognition, potty training and the love and exploration of learning.

I understand that there is no automatic reduction of fees when my child is on vacation or gone from Casa Montessori Preschool for any other reason.

I understand that if there is a global pandemic that is out of Casa Montessori's hands, tuition will still be expected to be paid monthly, unless otherwise stated by Casa Montessori.

I understand there is a returned check fee of \$20.00.

Two weeks advance written notice to Casa Montessori Preschool is required when withdrawing a child from Casa Montessori Preschool. If thirty days advance notice is not given, any prepaid tuition past two weeks will not be refunded.
